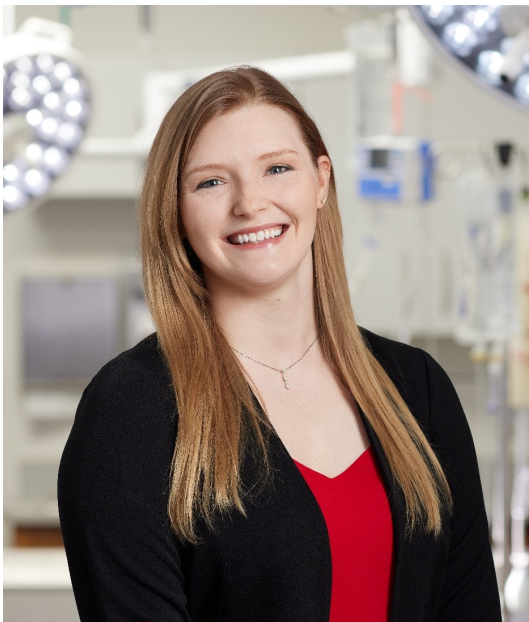




Christina Trujillo
